NACC applies for Bushfire grant

Narooma School of Arts has applied for a \$7.28m grant from the Bushfire Local Economic Recovery (BLER) Fund to build our long awaited Narooma Arts & Community Centre (NACC).

This would cover the full cost from detailed design including engineering, site works, construction and fitout, plus contingencies.

Analysis shows the benefits of the NACC Project far outweigh the costs. As you know, the design and amenity of the NACC has been extensively thought through and is a development ready project well supported by our community. It has Development Consent from Eurobodalla Shire Council.

Our application, complete with a substantial Business Case, Cost Benefit Ratio Datasheet, detailed Budget and programme

Thankfully the Steering Group intends sticking with us until the doors open, so lots lie ahead, including helping to access other funding sources should we not get this BLER grant.

Nerrigundah to Bermagui and Cobargo, an area heavily impacted by bushfires from 31 December to early February 2020 . The mental, physical and economic impact on the region has been considerable, impacts exacerbated by Covid-19 challenges.

Our Narooma township played a critical role during the bushfires as a relatively safe haven. It was a major evacuation area for holidaymakers and then longer term for residents in the wider area who

suffered a month of anxiety and fear of impending disaster as the fires continued burning in Narooma's hinterland. Some residents in surrounding areas lost everything. Then in late January, Narooma was also the base for several hundred firefighters from the Rural Fire Service and other agencies and for Australian Defence Forces personnel assisting bushfire impacted communities.

The NACC Project meets all assessment criteria for BLER funding but it is a highly competitive process. We won't hear if we have been successful for several months but meanwhile the Steering Group will be back at work.
